CLASSES

Combination Recreational

Focus on a combination of two different dance styles such as ballet and hip hop; participate in the recital.

Creative Movement/Ballet/Tap/Tumbling

Students learn basic steps and positions of tap, ballet and movement interpretation; class enhances memory, listening and sequencing skills; participate in the recital.

Dance Fitness

Dance fitness improves dance technique and performance through strengthening while improving coordination, balance, alignment and flexibility; open enrollment.

Jazz / Lyrical Jazz

Students learn step-by-step progressions and combinations to help further develop technique as they learn new and exciting choreography; participate in the recital.

Technique

Emphasis on proper posture and developing a good ballet foundation. These classes focus on flexibility, strengthening, and conditioning to develop the skills necessary to perform desired splits, leaps, tricks and to help develop beautiful dancer lines; open enrollment.

Musical Theater

Emphasis is on improvisation, creativity, character development, and choreography.

Competition / Performance Line

Designated for competition groups who are working on improving style, showmanship and precision of their dances. *Audition required.*

Superstar Ladies

For girls age 8 years and older and adult women, who love to dance, and would like to dance with their mother, niece, cousin or friend that are older or younger; participate in the recital.

Guyz and Dollz

For father, daughters, uncles and nieces, etc. who love to dance or like to perform and compete in dance competitions; participate in the recital.

Open Enrollment

Classes for students who want to dance without the commitment of purchasing a costume or participating in the recital. Open enrollment classes are available based on demand.

LEVELS

Beginner: 0-2 years of dance instruction
Intermediate: 3+ years of dance instruction
Advance: 4 + years of dance instruction

ATTENDANCE

Attendance is very important, not only to each individual, but to the entire class. Plan to attend class regularly and inform the Studio when your child will be absent.

CLASS OBSERVATION

Parents/guardians are welcome to observe the first class of each month. Depending on the teacher's preference and students' ability to focus during class, the curtain to the classroom window may be open or closed.

PRACTICE CD'S

CD's with the music your child will be using throughout the year will be available in late January.

PROFESSIONAL PICTURES

Professional pictures will be taken of your child in all costumes in April. These pictures are a great memento of your child's dance season. Class pictures appear in the recital program.

RETAIL

For your convenience, the Studio has leotards; tights; leggings; and used and new dance shoes as well as other dance items available for sale.
